

### **Great Southern Update – Solomon Brothers Group Action**

You may be aware of a proposed group action to be conducted by Solomon Brothers, lawyers based in Perth. The proposed action is to be funded by litigation funders, IMF. This action is specifically focused on Project Transform, and seeks to assist growers in projects from 1998 to 2003 who exchanged woodlots for shares as a result of Project Transform. Obviously, growers who exchanged woodlots for shares will not receive any distribution that might eventually be available to other growers through the Receivership of Great Southern.

Whilst we are aware of other litigation or proposed litigation concerning Great Southern, as far as we are aware this is the only proposed litigation which aims specifically at Project Transform.
