Urgent Call to Action – 2007 and 2008 schemes

Dear Grower,

As you are aware the 2007 and 2008 GS schemes have had no commercial party demonstrate any interest at this point in time.

It would appear that Gunns have no interest in taking over the management of the schemes.

However, we have been in discussions with another commercial party who we believe are likely to make a commercial offer to take over the management of the schemes on adjusted commercial terms.

In anticipation of this offer, we want to ensure that we can call a meeting of growers to consider the proposition and vote on the outcome of their scheme.

With this in mind we ask you to give power of attorney to Robert Burns, Chairman of Save My Trees, and Philip Capicchiano, Committee member of Save My Trees, to facilitate this process.

We wish to be very clear that the sole purpose of this request is to ensure growers have a properly constituted forum to consider and vote on the proposal which will be released in due course by the bidder.

In order to legally call a meeting on behalf of growers we need to achieve at least 5% of grower votes in both years .

We would ask that you urgently consider this request and if in favour, to please return your executed power of attorney.

We would request that you return all grower proxies by COB Friday of 25th of June, 2010 (we will however be accepting late proxies if necessary).

The receivers have indicated that they have advertised for the sale of the great southern land bank and there is great danger that the leases will be terminated and growers will receive little or no value for their investments in the 2007 and 2008 schemes.

Providing power of attorney to call a grower meeting is therefore crucial in helping to preserve grower interests.

Save my trees is firmly of the opinion that growers should have the opportunity to consider the forthcoming offer and decide the fate of their schemes.

2. To be executed on page 4 by the entity that is the Grower (i.e. personally, trustee of trust or company as applicable). This can be matched to the registers.
3. Page 5 details of Grower to be completed and scheme (1 or both) indicated. One PoA can be completed for both schemes if applicable.
